## Location

### Nearest postcode:

IV47 8TA for Fairy Pools car park.

IV47 8SG for the Loch Eynort car park.

### How to get here

From the Skye Bridge take the A87 north to Sligachan and turn left onto the A863 towards Dunvegan. After about 5 miles (8 km) turn left onto the B8009 and left again for Glenbrittle.

For Loch Eynort car park, continue along the B8009 another ½ mile, then turn left for 4 miles to the car park.

## Trail Information



### Eynort Loop ●●●

A quiet loop starting from the edge of Loch Eynort, or as part of the Bealach Brittle Loop. Great for views out onto the loch and hills and watch sea birds.

A firm well surfaced forest road, than can be uneven in places and wet after rain. Can be fairly steep for long gradients.
