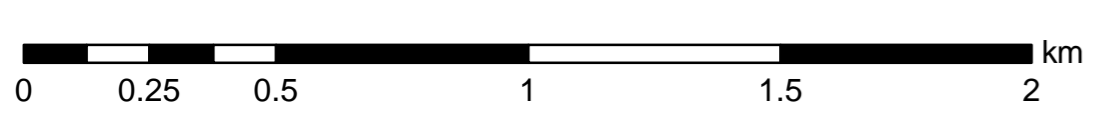

Definitions

Low impact silviculture - Alternative to clearfelling, also referred to as Continuous Cover Forestry, that encourages structural and species diversity and evolutionary adaptation by promoting natural regeneration

Minimum intervention - Management with only basic inputs required to protect the forest or to ensure succession of key habitats and species
