3. Quarterly Timber Market Update

Mick Bottomley presented income and volume forecasts, including monthly income projections and FLS' current financial profile. Variance between predicted and actual timber volume and unit income was highlighted, then contextualised by information on indicative market conditions.

Mick outlined FLS' targets for priority contract completion over the seasonal harvesting season and advised of fortnightly contract liaison meetings with Regions and customers.
