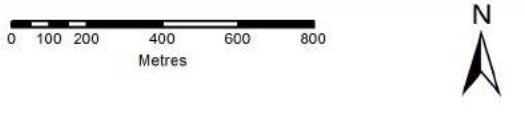


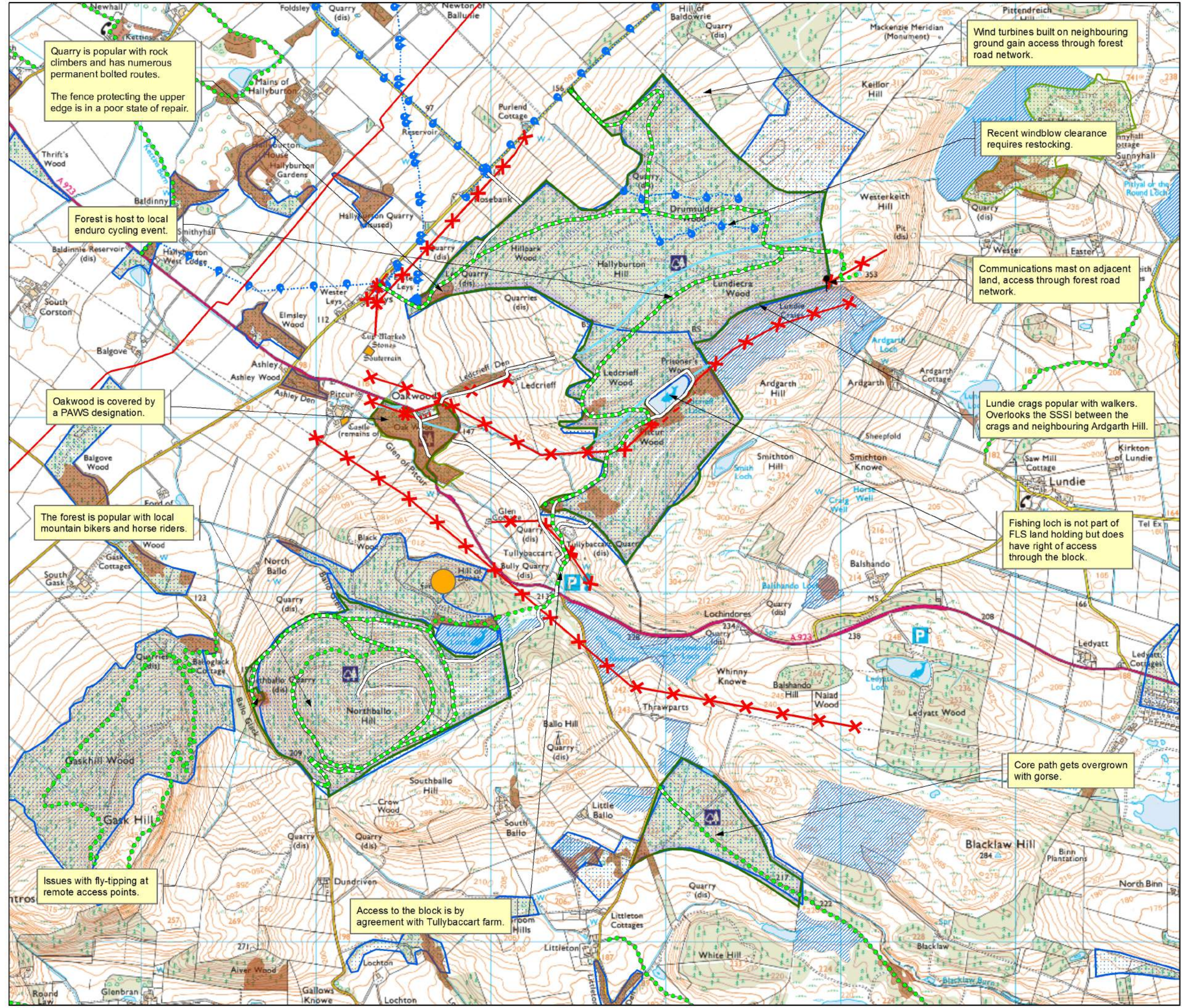

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Quarry is popular with rock climbers and has numerous permanent bolted routes.  
The fence protecting the upper edge is in a poor state of repair.

Forest is host to local enduro cycling event.

Oakwood is covered by a PAWS designation.

The forest is popular with local mountain bikers and horse riders.

Issues with fly-tipping at remote access points.

Access to the block is by agreement with Tullybaccart farm.

Wind turbines built on neighbouring ground gain access through forest road network.

Recent windblow clearance requires restocking.

Communications mast on adjacent land, access through forest road network.

Lundie crags popular with walkers. Overlooks the SSSI between the crags and neighbouring Ardgarth Hill.

Fishing loch is not part of FLS land holding but does have right of access through the block.

Core path gets overgrown with gorse.
