




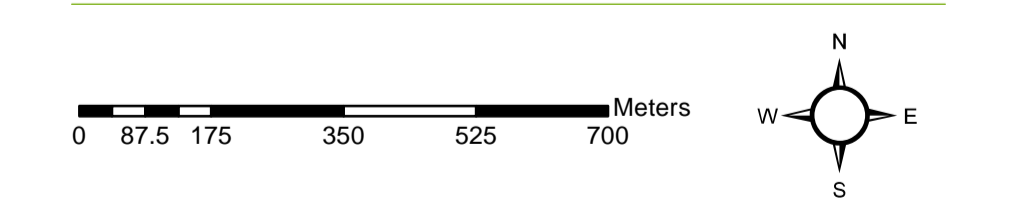

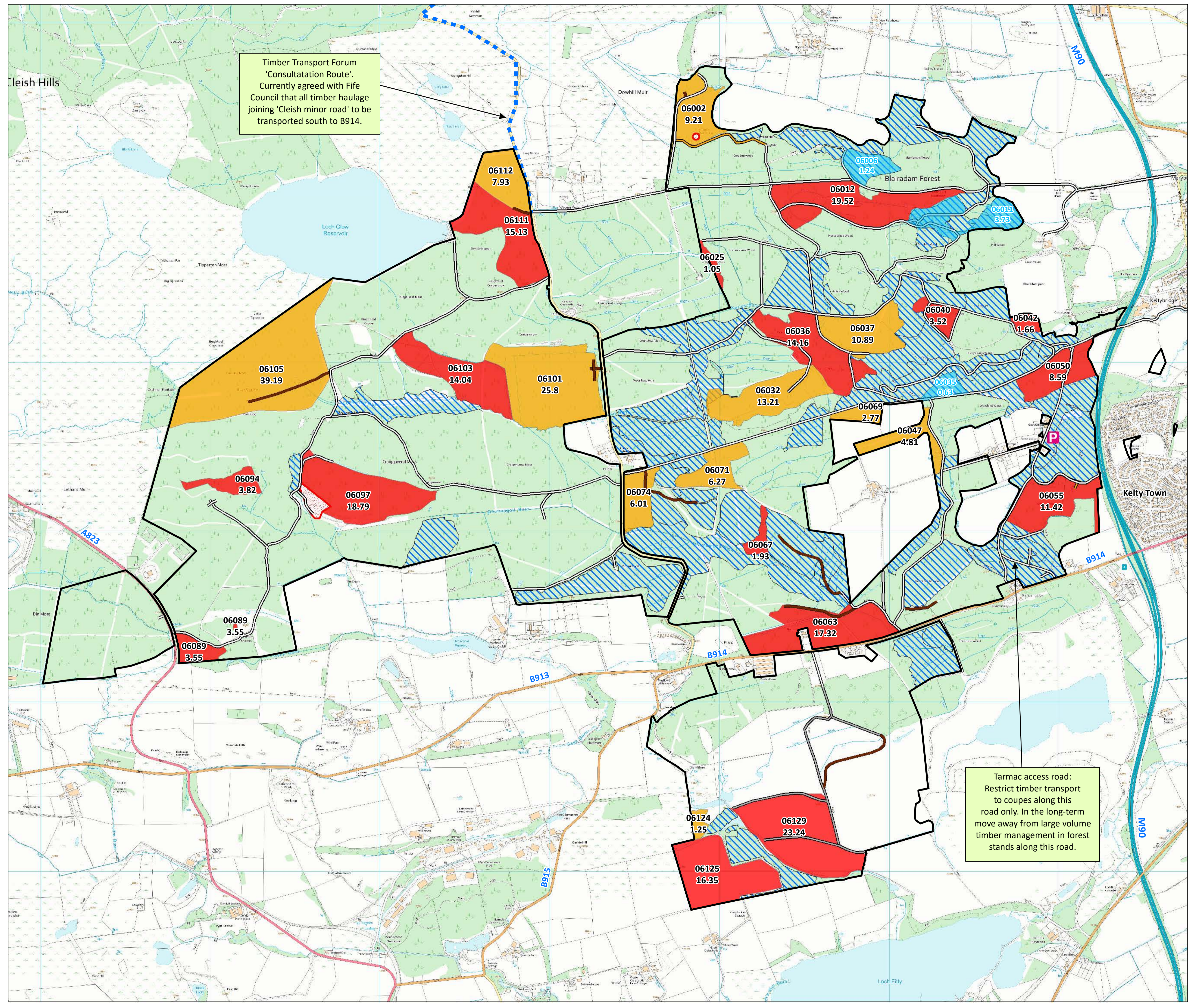

Timber Transport Forum 'Consultation Route'. Currently agreed with Fife Council that all timber haulage joining 'Cleish minor road' to be transported south to B914.

Tarmac access road: Restrict timber transport to coupes along this road only. In the long-term move away from large volume timber management in forest stands along this road.
