

Coulaghailtro Issues and Objectives Map:

Accessible Text

To be read clockwise around the map:

- Wetland habitats Restore and maintain areas of bog/wetland habitat where appropriate, and other priority/protected species and habitats. Select suitable tree species for soil type.
- **FLS fencing** Ensure fencing appropriate and maintained as required.
- **Timber** Maintain sustainable quality timber production.
- Coupes Ensure that coupes relate to landscape character and scenic quality. Scale, shape and plan coupes to maximise cost efficiencies for felling, access provision and reestablishment effectiveness.
- Operational access Currently no operational access to southern half of block. Plan and construct cost effective access to inaccessible crops and for establishment success.
- Deer management Provide opportunity for appropriate and effective deer management and integration with neighbouring landowner deer management.
- Heritage features Ensure features are protected.
- Ancient Woodland Sites (AWS) Identify, protect and enhance AWS.
- Core path Core path (C295c) follows route of B8024 bordering southern and western edge of block. Ensure operations don't affect core path and it remains accessible.
- Roading and access In forest timber road, maintain and ensure accessibility. Severely 'restricted' and 'consultation' sections of the B8024. See TTMP B8024 Kilberry Loop Road - Ormsary - North to A83 Inverneill plan.
- Utilities Protect infrastructure and ensure correct buffer zones.
- **Community and landowners** Ensure liaison and consultation.
- Larch Develop a programme to remove most of larch in phase 1 or phase 2. If phase 1 not feasible.
- Private Water Supplies Protect water supplies. Enhance buffers and maintain access as required.
- **Tree species** Diversify the forest block in terms of age and species as appropriate.
- **Drinking water catchment and watercourses** Protect drinking water and enhance riprarian corridors.
- Local Landscape Area Maintain and enhance views.
