How To Find Us

From Oban:

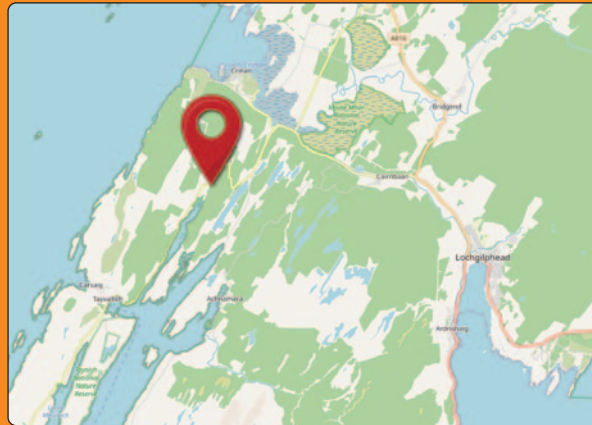
follow the A816 south to Cairnbaan 35 miles

From Lochgilphead:

follow the A816 north to Cairnbaan 2.4 miles

From Cairnbaan:

follow B841 for 3 miles. Turn left onto B8025 for Tayvallich. After 1 mile the centre is signed left at the top of the hill. Turn onto track and follow for 600 metres to car park.

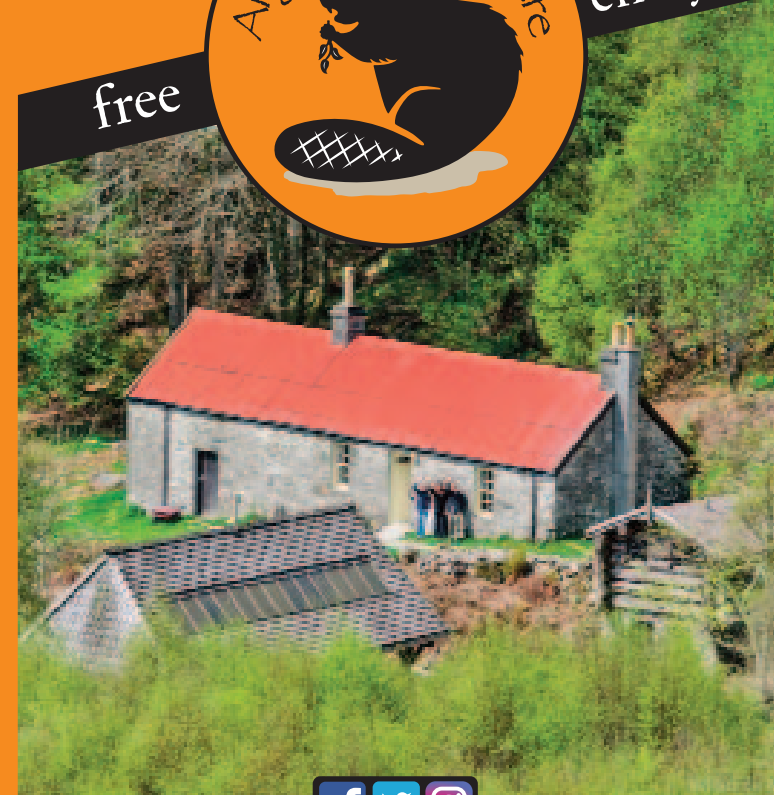

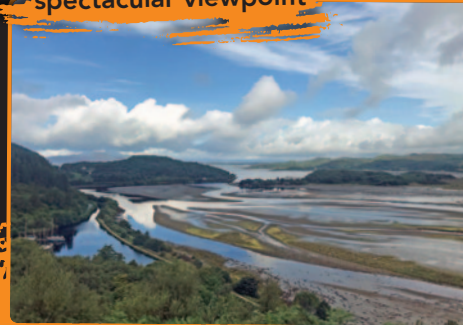
