

Slattadale Pre-Covid Engagement Work.

The parent council has very strong links with the whole community and has recently opened up the public conversation about Slattadale. We teamed up with a community arts project over the summer and autumn 2019 to publicise the rekindling of Slattadale. This took the form of 2 high profile events and 3 smaller events and reached over 400 people.

We produced and distributed fliers, and are collaborating with a local enterprise company in Planning for Real community consultation.

The group arranged a stand at the local Christmas fayre, and entered a Slattadale Interactive Christmas tree into the community festival to advertise our plans and spread the word, and receive ideas, and feedback. In addition, the organisational message has been spread by way of radio interviews, social media campaigns, and community consultation events:
