Design Concept

Objective 2 Design Concept:
Landscape upper margin and NBL species distribution, subject to the overriding objective of slope stabilisation. Increase deer control on open hill to reduce long term impacts on vegetation contrast created by deer fencing.

Objective 1 Design Concept:
Set up a project to identify the most expedient and lowest risk method of felling & extracting the current timber crop and establishing protection forest as both a restock and woodland creation on the upper margin. Liaise with Transport Scotland to agree proposals, additional engineering mitigation and traffic management.

Objective 3 Design Concept:
Upper margin to be re-shaped to avoid straight line and better reflect the hollow, as viewed from the south side of Loch Long. Increased deer control will encourage the development of a softer transition between the woodland and open ground across the rocky outcrops on the forest edge.

Objective 4 Design Concept:
Retain and manage areas with CCF potential where feasible. Utilise diverse conifers where appropriate and retain/create open ground along significant burns.
