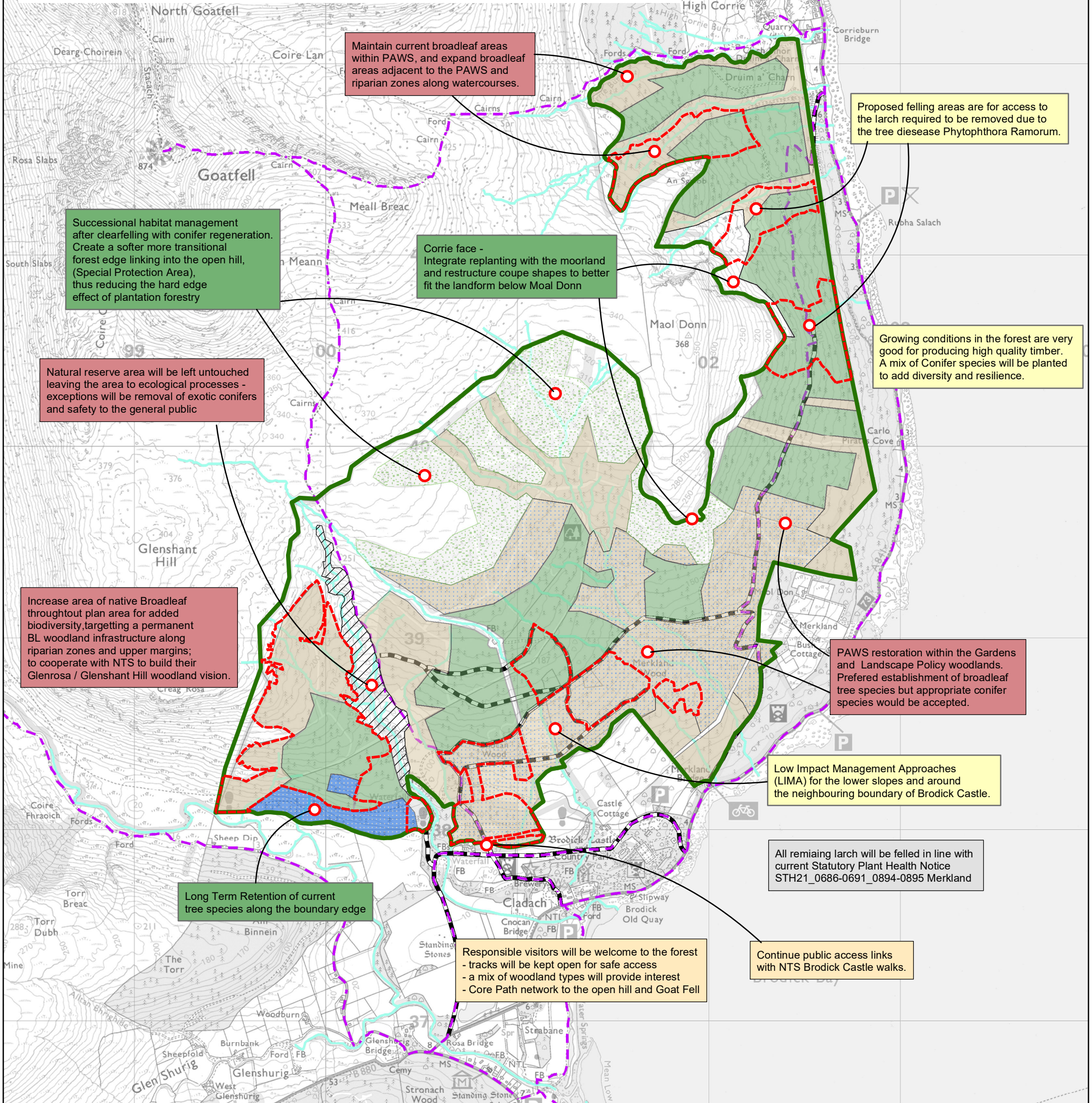


Merkland Land Management Plan 2023 - 2033

The main objectives for this plan are:

- 1) Tree Health - Removal of all Larch due to infection of Phytophthora ramorum, and help reduce the spread of the disease.
- 2) Landscape / Visitor experience - Integrate FLS and NTS and reinforce the Gardens and Designed Landscape.
- 3) Native Woodland - restoration and enhancement of ancient woodland sites and connectivity with the wider woodland habitat network.
- 4) Management of natural regeneration and create a transition zone between forest and open hill,















Concept
