

Thinning will normally be carried out at or below the level of marginal thinning intensity (i.e. removing no more than 70% of the maximum MAI or YC per year. Higher intensities (no more than 140% of maximum MAI or YC per year) may be applied where thinning has been delayed, larger tree sizes are sought or as part of a LISS prescription. In all cases workplans will define the detailed thinning prescription before work is carried out and operations will be monitored by checking pre and post thinning basal areas for key crop components.

Kirriedarroch Thinning Map

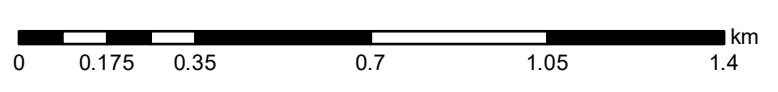
