Aultmore LTP Map 3: Key Features and Issues

- Plant Health: there are areas of DNB infected crop across the block. The severity of the infection varies greatly.
- Water supply: private water supply points and pipelines within forest. A combination of live and abandoned infrastructure.
- Watercourses: several watercourses originate from the forest including the Aultmore Burn which is a tributary of the River Isla.
- Six of SEPA's Waterbody Catchments are present in Aultmore
- Recreation: formal and informal paths through Aultmore, including the Fish Wives Path.
- Larch offers structural and age diversity.
- Peatland restoration: areas of deep peat have been identified across Aultmore and will be assessed for peatland restoration.
- Part of the western end of Aultmore falls into a Capercaillie Core Area
- A quarry extension is required to facilitate planned operations.
- The majority of Aultmore falls within the Muriesk Intake (River Devron) water catchment
- Areas of young crop currently not performing at timber production objectives.
