




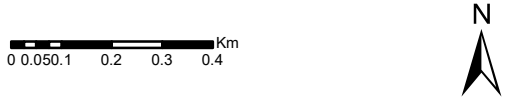

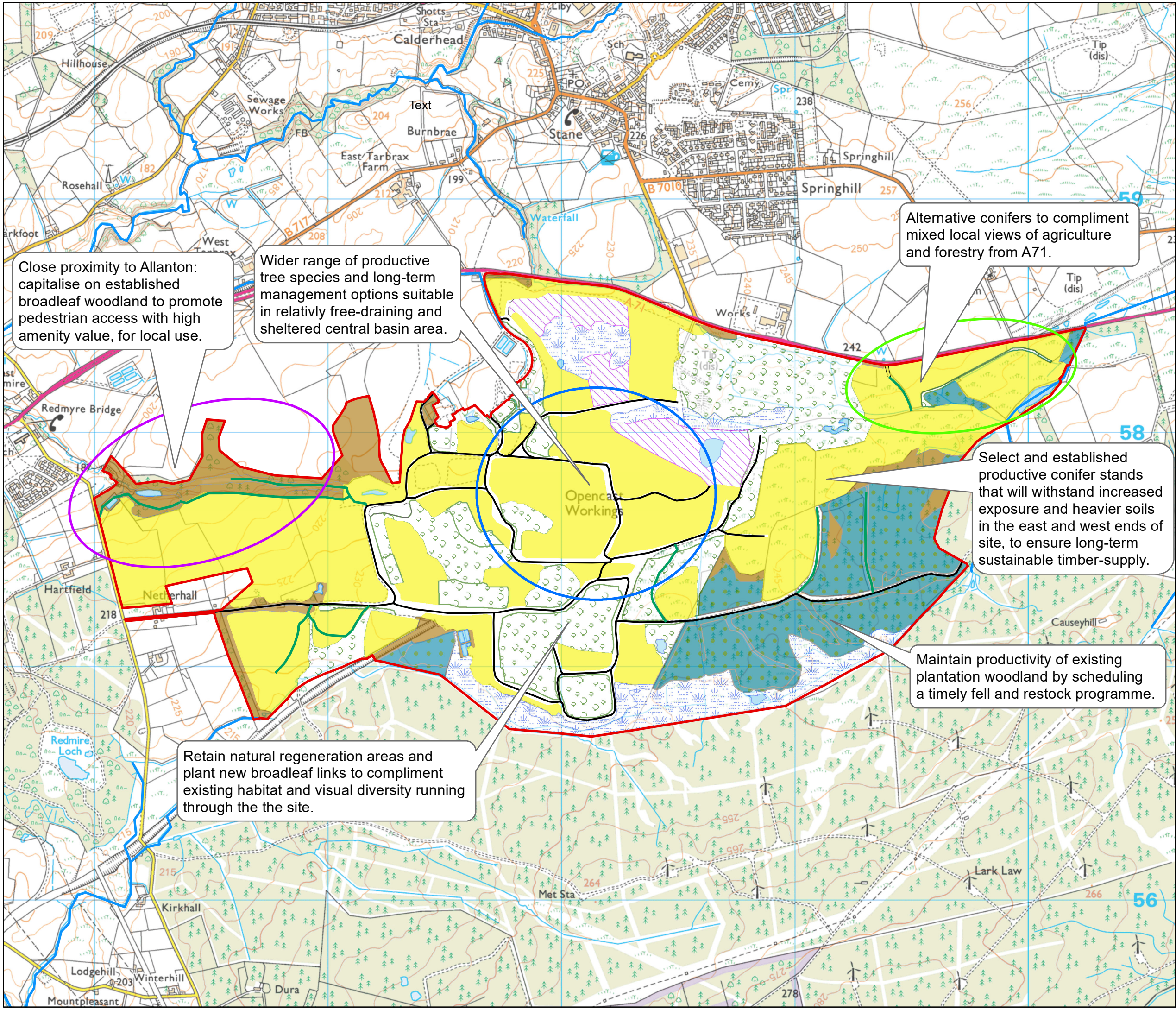

Close proximity to Allanton: capitalise on established broadleaf woodland to promote pedestrian access with high amenity value, for local use.

Wider range of productive tree species and long-term management options suitable in relatively free-draining and sheltered central basin area.

Alternative conifers to compliment mixed local views of agriculture and forestry from A71.

Select and established productive conifer stands that will withstand increased exposure and heavier soils in the east and west ends of site, to ensure long-term sustainable timber-supply.

Maintain productivity of existing plantation woodland by scheduling a timely fell and restock programme.

Retain natural regeneration areas and plant new broadleaf links to compliment existing habitat and visual diversity running through the the site.
