Strathdon LTP Map 8: Concept (1 of 2)

- Assess ecological potential of the Area of Long Established Woodland of plantation origin and work towards maintaining / improving habitat.
- Clear fell windblow area and restructure around watercourse with native mixed broadleaves.
- Potential area for peatland habitat restoration. Remove overstorey crop and survey the full extent of the area's hydrological unit.
- Introduce a programme to remove non-native natural regeneration from areas of open habitat.
- Area of mature crop that is at Maximum Mean Annual Increment with areas of windblow present. Assess stability and retain the most stable areas for the red squirrel habitat.
- Maintain open ground around the Newe's Craig Scheduled Monument.
- Extend quarry to facilitate with required road maintenance.
- Restocked with Scots pine and native mixed broadleaves to act as a buffer to the open area habitat and adjacent Morvern and Mullachdubh Site of Special Scientific Interest and Special Area of Conservation.
- Low visibility within the landscape allows for larger clearfells to support commercial activity within the block in Zone 2.
- Monitor mature Larch and thin out to maintain air flow within the crop, if required.
- Monitor young Larch on steep slopes for signs of *Phytophthora ramorum*.
- Remove conifers around the watercourse and establish a riparian corridor that extends into a peat edge woodland habitat.
