

Pitmedden and Weddersby Land **Management Plan**

Pitmedden Issues summary

- Third party access required for two properties
- Exposed edge of forest facing north west is suffering from windblow
- Torflundy SAC for amphibians, network of ponds and watercourse habitat for amphibians
- Mature and well thinned stands of spruce, larch and pine
- High recreational use by mountain bikers and informal car parking at the Glen Foot entrance.
- Core path network throughout forest and a number of Rights of Way within the forest.
- Waterbodies and watercourses throughout the forest, often tree regeneration encroaching.
- Popular car park for local use in the Clink.
- Diverse species and age forest in the Clink.
- Overhead pylons cut through the forest
- Lochmill Loch SSSI for lowland heath open habitat

Weddersby Issues summary

- Very fertile soils resulting in dense weed growth in restock sites
- Unofficial mountain bike trails are popular
