

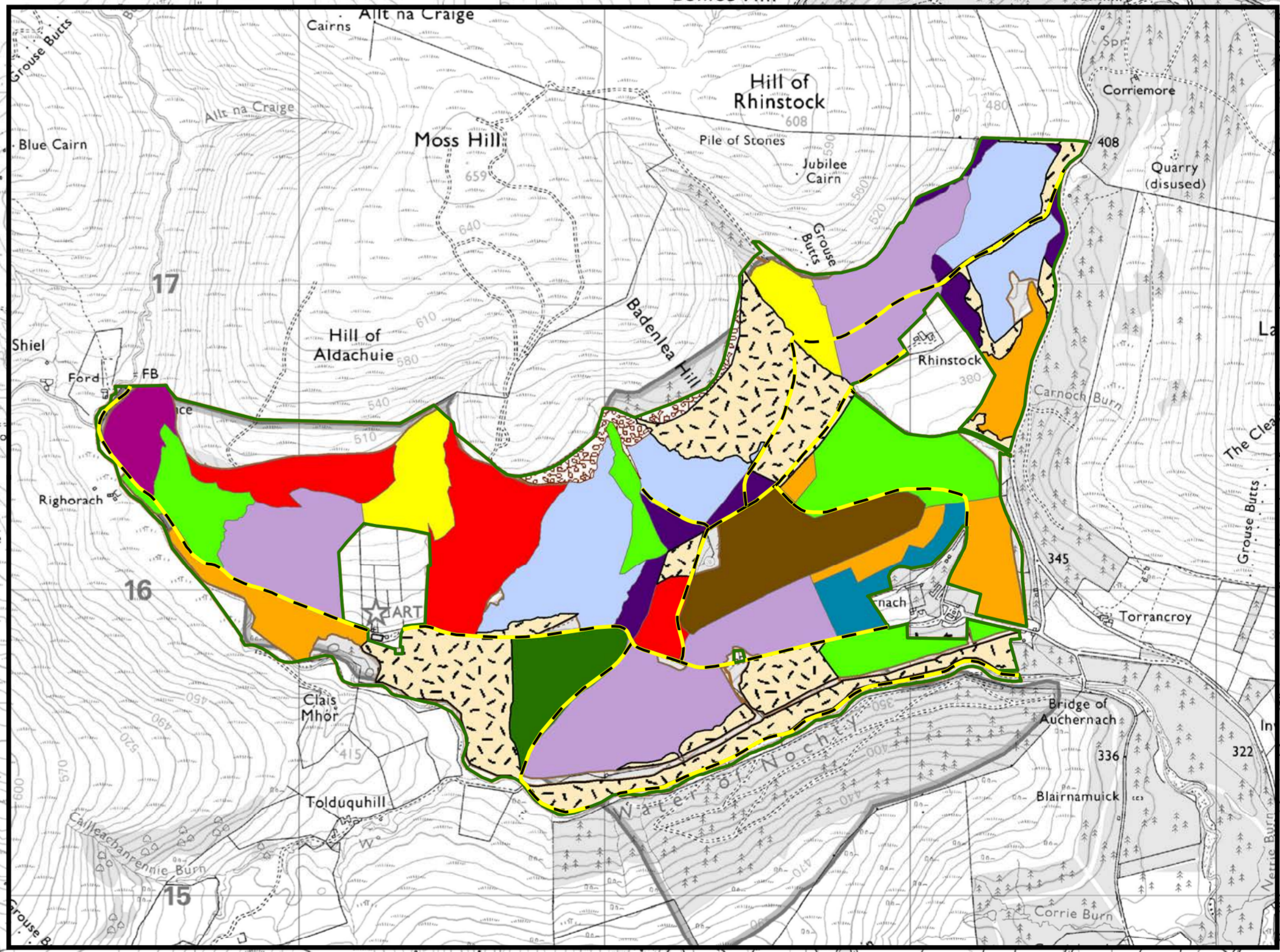
Areas removed from Low Impact Silvicultural System (LISS) due to their unsuitability. The ground conditions are either too wet or steep to thin regularly, as required for successful LISS.

Area of DNB recently felled and awaiting restock.

Phase 1 & 2 felling coupes are predominantly to remove Lodgepole pine with DNB infection to reduce the inoculum loading in the area and reduce the risk of the Scots pine getting badly infected.

Long term retention of suitable crops to connect with open ground to create forest habitat networks.

Felling for quarry extension.
