


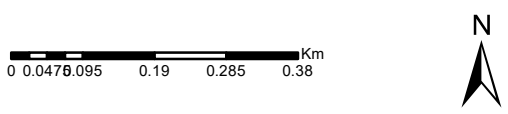


Map 6: Future Habitats and Species

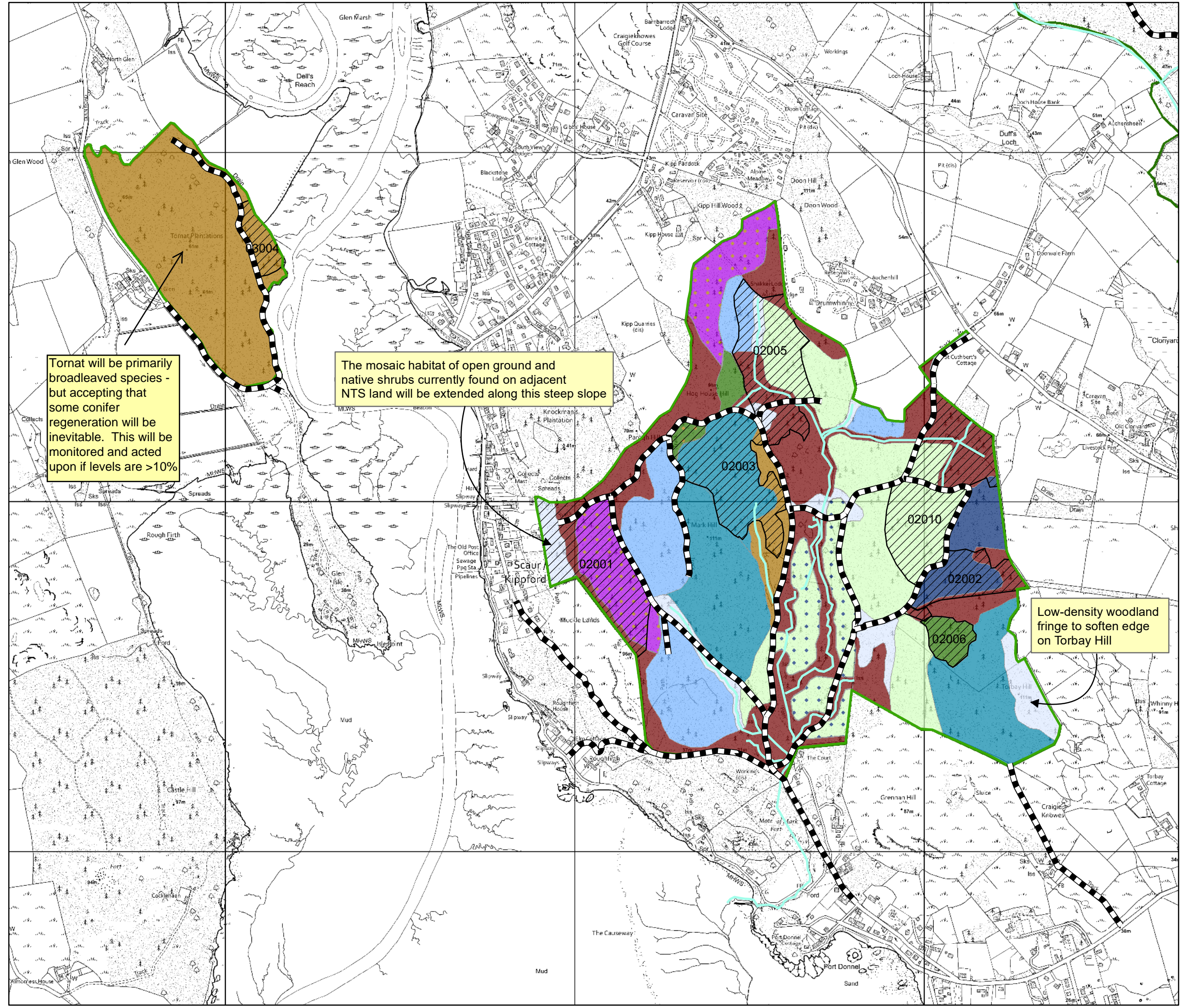
