Glen Loin Woods include area of SSSI and SAC.

Heritage features in south are the remains of Creag t-Searraich farm, and designed landscape of Glenloin House (outside of FLS land).

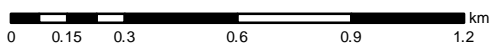
Heritage features on east side are relic plantation enclosures and old military road remnants.
