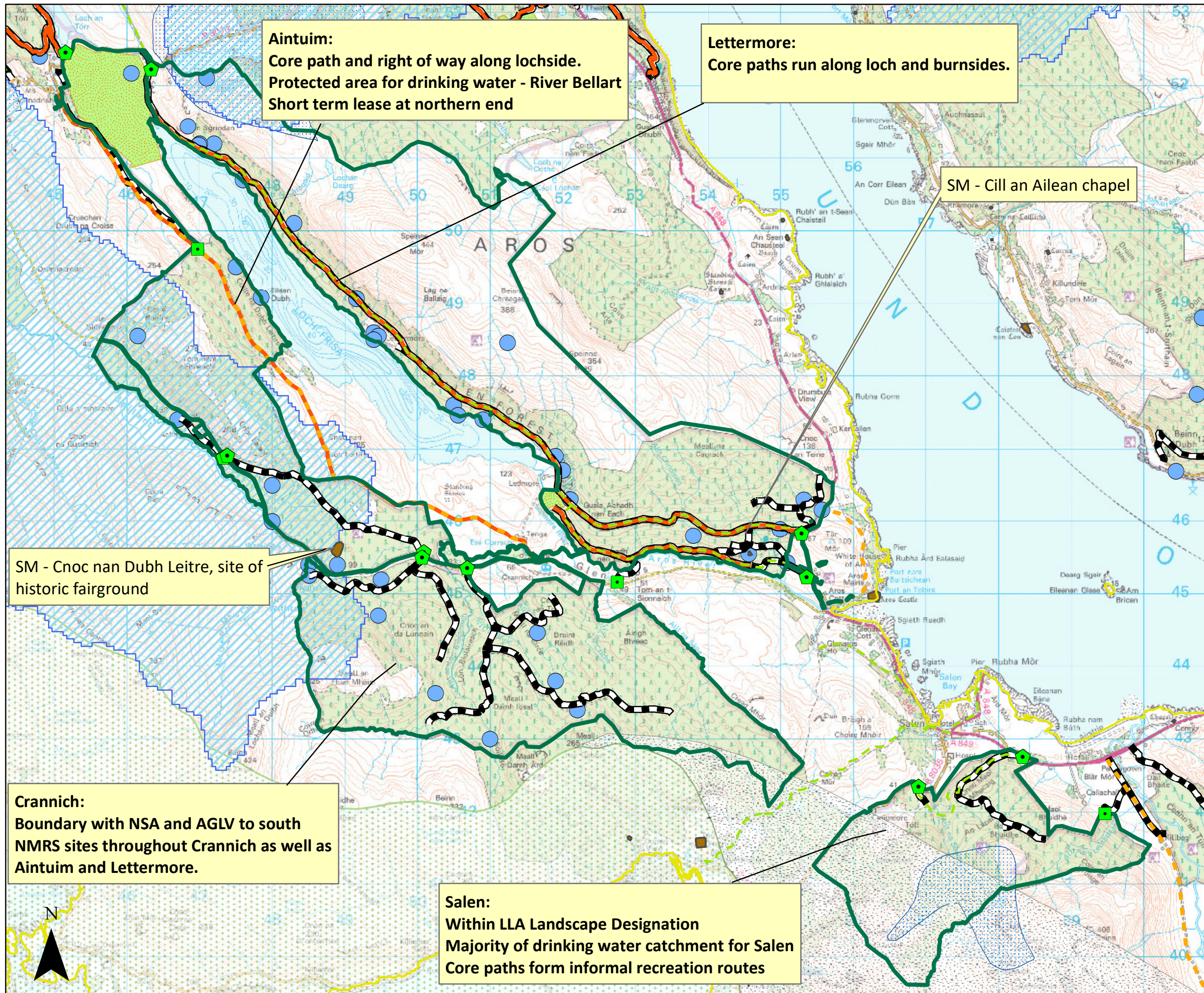


Map 9 Central Mull LMP

Protected area for drinking water - River Bellart
Short term lease at northern end

Lettermore:
Core paths run along loch and burnsides.

SM - Cill an Ailean chapel

SM - Cnoc nan Dubh Leitire, site of historic fairground

Crannich:
Boundary with NSA and AGLV to south
NMRS sites throughout Crannich as well as Aintuim and Lettermore.

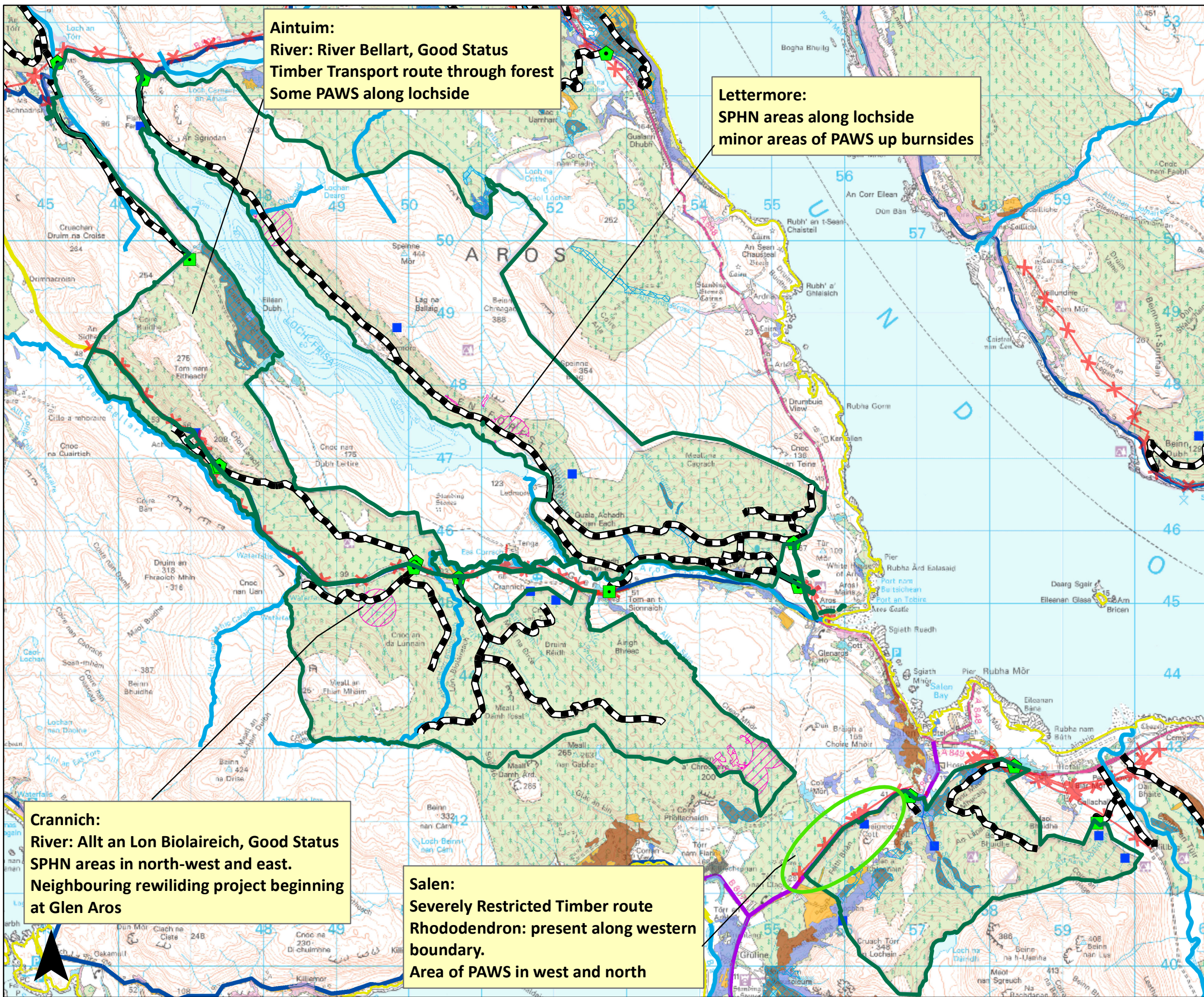
Salen:
Within LLA Landscape Designation
Majority of drinking water catchment for Salen
Core paths form informal recreation routes

minor areas of PAWS up burnside

Crannich:
River: Allt an Lon Biolaireich, Good Status
SPHN areas in north-west and east.
Neighbouring rewilding project beginning at Glen Aros

Salen:
Severely Restricted Timber route
Rhododendron: present along western boundary.
Area of PAWS in west and north
